CARE SYMBOL

WASHING:



DO NOT WASH

Articles with this label should not be washed. They may also be sensitive to any wet treatment or be unsuitable for treatment in a household washing machine due to their size.



HAND WASH

Water temperature max. 40°C depending on the article. First dissolve detergent in plenty of water. Allow the textiles to float in the solution and agitate carefully. Do not rub, pull or wring out. Then rinse the textiles well, press the water out carefully and pull into shape. Treat coloured and sensitive pieces of laundry rapidly and do not leave lying in the wet state.



EASY CARE

For "easy care" articles, for example made from modal, viscose or synthetic fibres (acrylic, polyester and polyamide). Reduce the quantity of laundry (the drum should be up to half full). Select an appropriate washing programme. Select a short spin or do not spin at all due to risk of creasing.



DELICATES / WOOL WASH

For articles made from machine-washable wool, for example. This washing cycle features an especially gentle mechanical treatment. Reduce the quantity of laundry substantially (the drum should only be up to one third full).



DO NOT DRY CLEAN

It is not possible to dry clean these articles.



DO NOT BLEACH

DRYING:



NORMAL DRYING PROCESSES

Dry in a tumble dryer using a normal cycle and temperature (80°C without limitations).



MILD DRYING PROCESSES

Caution is appropriate when tumble drying. Select a mild process with reduced thermal action (60°C) and duration of cycle.



DO NOT TUMBLE DRY

IRONING:



IRON AT LOW TEMPERATURE

Maximum temperature of the sole plate 110°C. Corresponds to "acrylic, polyamide" setting on an iron. If necessary, iron shiny or pressure-sensitive articles with a dry intermediate cloth or inside out. Do not iron with steam.



IRON AT MODERATE TEMPERATURE

Maximum sole plate temperature 150°C. Corresponds to "Wool/silk/polyester/viscose" setting on an iron. Iron under a moderately moist intermediate cloth. A steam iron can be used. Avoid heavy pressure.
